THERE'S SOMETHING NO IN THE WATER



We all know that city water contains really nasty things. Chlorine, corrosion inhibitor chemicals, arsenic, lead, pesticides, herbicides, PFAS, pharmaceutical drugs & parasites can all be present in treated tap water.

For this reason, many parronts choose to give their birds reverse osmosis or distilled water to drink.

Reverse osmosis & distilled water also have a downside: all trace minerals have been removed.

There's been a lot of debate over whether or not this is a problem, the main question being: does drinking distilled or RO water lead to demineralization of the body. More specifically: organ function & demineralizing bone.

A bird's small body has a high metabolic demans & is so susceptible to imbalances...

How how can they not be affected?

A study by the World Health Organization stated: "It has been adequately demonstrated that consuming water of low mineral content has a negative effect on homeostasis mechanisms, compromising the mineral and water metabolism in the body" Ie: it removes minerals from the body.

I'm sure this is one of those situations where there could be a pile of studies on either side of the debate, but it's so simple to add trace minerals to the water, why take the chance? I know it's made a difference for me with my RO water. Something to think about;)

HOW TO GASLIGHT YOUR HOOMAN

"Of all the tools under a bird's wing, gaslighting is my favorite way to manipulate my hooman"

Like all birds in the parrot family, Grayson was hatched with the natural ability to manipulate.

Though, experts have put him in the gifted or prodigy category. Grayson learned to vocalize at only 3 months of age. Sure, talking was fun, but Grayson was more interested in how he could use this new skill to gaslight his mom.

Still very young, Grayson's methods of gaslighting are mainly centered around the first commands that baby birds learn: Step Up & Come Here. They may be simple tactics, but very effective for making his first-time bird mom think she's going crazy.



Here are young Grayson's favorites that he would like all birds to practice daily:

- Grayson calls out his mom's request of 'Come Here'... But he doesn't come.
- Again saying "Come Here"... but then he walks away from mom.
- A variation, Grayson says the "Step up" command, then walks away calling himself a good boy
- Calls himself a good boy *before* stepping up
- Stepping up on cue, but then immediately flies away.
- Asking for scritches, then getting mad when mom follows through.

USING RECEIPT PAPER ROLLS AS TOYS

Bisphenol A (BPA) and it's nearly identical replacement, BPS, coat receipt paper. BPA is the chemical that was banned from baby bottles in 2010 because it's a hormone disrupting toxin. PBA's absorb through the our skin, so it will absorb much faster when chewed on by our birds. PBA & PBS are linked to hormone-based cancers.

cupcake liners in toys

PFAS coat some cupcake liners. You know, the non-stick "forever chemicals" like Teflon. PFAS aren't just a danger when heated, when ingested or absorbed through the skin, these toxic chemicals lower immunity, increase allergies, cause cardiovascular disease, are endocrine disruptors, can cause kidney cancer & more. 'Wilton' brand cupcake liners were found to have 17 ppm of PFAS; If You Care' brand has 12 ppm. Brands found safe at the time of testing were 'Eoonfirst Jumbo" and 'Gifbera Natural Standard.' Bottom line: look for studies to see which brands have been tested PFAS-





PLAYING WITH ZIPPERS

It's not just an issue of zipper teeth being broken off & ingested, but what the zippers are made from. Most zippers are made from brass (= copper + zinc), zinc coated steel, pure zinc, chrome, questionable aluminum alloys & nickel alloys.

So basically toxic heavy metals.

On the rare occasion, zippers will be made from safe stainless steel. But the likelihood of knowing what your zipper is made from is low, right?
