THE DANGERS OF PERFUMES



Did you know: 3,500+ synthetic chemicals are used in perfume today? Companies are not required to list those chemicals – they all just neatly tuck under the word "fragrance". Most of those synthetic chemicals are not safe; many are classified as highly toxic. Linked to endocrine disruption, cancer, organ toxicity, reproductive & development toxicity & immunotoxicity. Those are just the dangers for people.

How much more toxic would those synthetic fragrance chemicals be for birds?

We know that birds have extremely sensitive respiratory systems. Birds air sacs are designed to be more efficient at oxygen metabolism, which makes them more susceptible to toxic compounds. Death from breathing in too many volatile compounds in the air can happen vey quickly or slowly with small doses of toxins every day. Of course, birds can also absorb toxic compounds through their skin.



I'm one of those weirdos with chemical sensitivities. Since 1999, I haven't been able to be around any synthetic compounds without feeling sick. Building materials, cleaning products, body care products... So I've been making people & parrot-safe perfume for a few decades.

SAFETY TIPS from this issue

Essential Oils and birds

Essential oils can kill your bird if you don't use them safely! Research which are safe & which are toxic, even when diluted in a carrier oil.



NEVER:

- * use undiluted essential oils
- * diffuse, aerosol or spray essential oils
- * heat essential oils (steam, candles, melts, plug-in diffusers
- * blend essential oils with water & spray in the air

Don't let your bird play with metal guitar strings

of metals that are
toxic to parrots:
Bronze (copper + tin)
Brass (copper + zinc)
Nickel strings RUST
quickly (rust is toxic).



Safe Houseplants

Many houseplants are toxic to birds, so parronts need to make sure they are bringing in safe species.

BUT:

If you live in a country where houseplants are imported from other countries, be aware that those plants are HEAVILY sprayed with toxic pesticides & herbicides before crossing the border.

Even if you have a non-toxic species, it's best to replace all of the soil & cut the plant back to the roots.

Or, easier, get slips from old plants at a friend's house.
